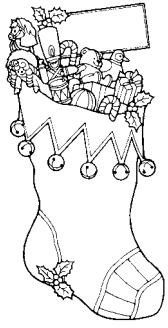




## Christmas Sudoku – Easy

Directions: Instead of the digits 1 – 9, use the letters SNOWFLAKE. Each 9 x 9 grid must contain one of each letter.

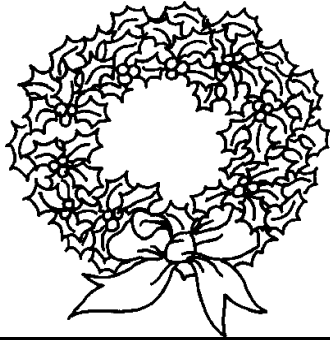

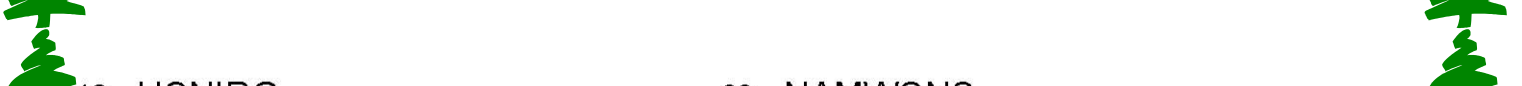
